Parks Victoria is proposing a name change for the Canadian Regional Park to Woowookarung and have commenced public consultation. The online survey may be found at www.parks.vic.gov.au/woowookarung. Deadline for comment is October 14.

"Woowookarung embodies the spirit and the history of this place, which provided food, medicine, water, shelter and raw materials for Aboriginal people. In Wadawurrung language Woowookarung means place of plenty": Uncle Bryon Powell, Elder and Chair of Wadawurrung.

In association with this, a new Friends group is being formed. A meeting of the Friends of the Canadian Corridor (FoCC) will be held at 7pm Thursday October 20th at Mt Clear Scout Hall for the purpose of incorporation of the group.
